The Heritage Day Celebration includes a tour of many of the town's charming pioneer-era homes and buildings, built along Main Street and in the Downtown area. Tickets for the home tours cost \$10 for adults and \$5 for children, and are sold at the Old Spring City School, and funds benefit preservation and restoration efforts in Spring City.

An art and antique sale is also held at the Old Spring City School. A silent auction, called "Art Squared," is held at the school, where patrons bid on one-foot square paintings done by well known Spring City artists including Osral Allred, Lee Bennion, Susan Gallacher, M'Lisa Paulsen, Doug Fryer, Kathleen Peterson, Cassandra Parsons, and many other Utah artists.

Additional artwork by well-known artists will be available for sale in the Old School and in local galleries. Breakfast and lunch is served at the Spring City bowery and is sponsored by the local LDS ward. Spring City is just off Highway 89, between Mt. Pleasant and Ephraim. It may be sunny in Spring City while rainy on the Wasatch Front, and the homes and art are lovely, whatever the weather!
